

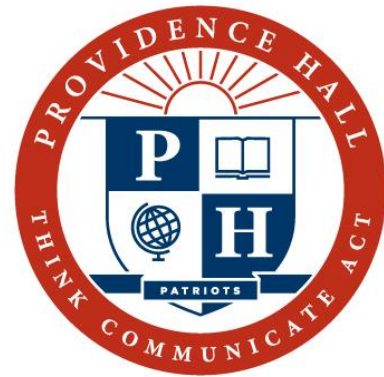

School Plan Summary

Providence Hall seeks to inspire students through inquiry teaching methodology. As an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School, we are authorized to offer three programs, Primary Years Program (PYP) for grades K-5, Middle Years Program (MYP) for grades 6-8, and Diploma Years (DP) for grades 11-12. The emphasis of this program is inquiry based, student centered instruction; teaching students how to think, not just what to think.

To support and encourage learning we continue to train, mentor and foster IB practices with our teachers. In order to accomplish this goal staff and administration have created a plan to maintain professional learning with our school community.

- Every teacher will be trained in IB teaching methods.
- The Inquiry process will be taught and followed in all classrooms.
- Intervention classes are available for tier 2 students. MTSS Intervention collaboration/strategies are implemented for students
- Students learn on their individual instructional levels in all subject areas. Spanish is taught in grades K-6 and students may continue learning Spanish or Chinese in 9-12th grades.

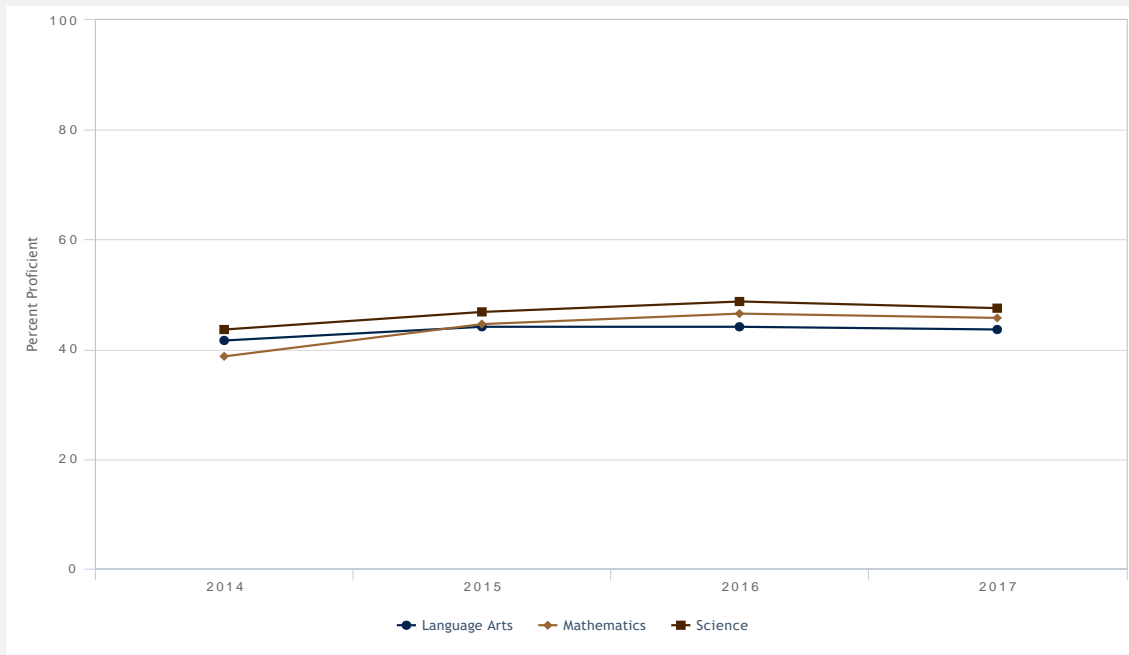

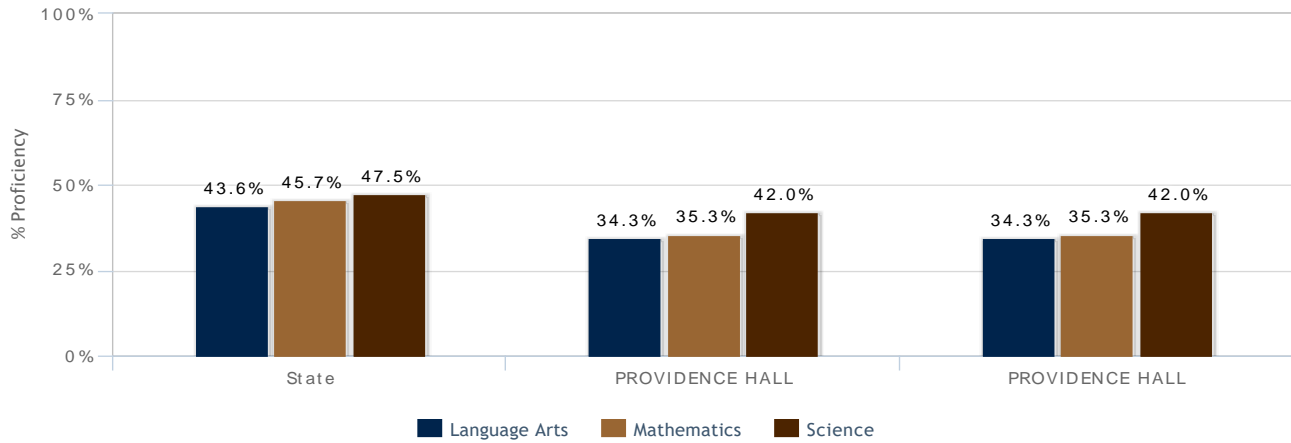

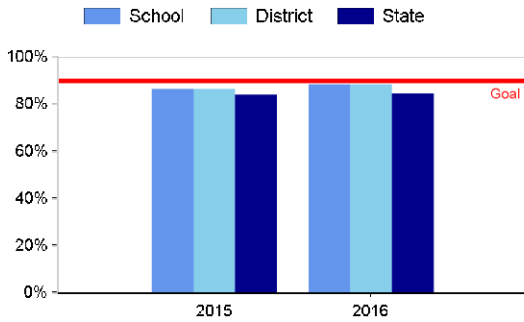

Graduation Rate



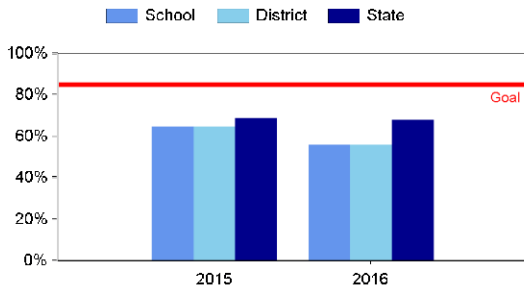

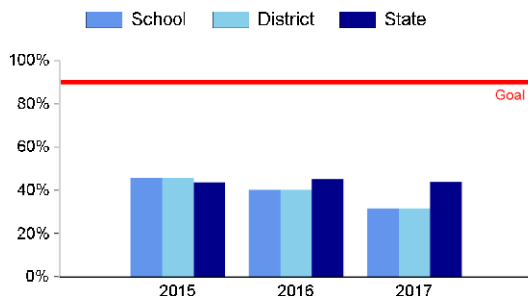

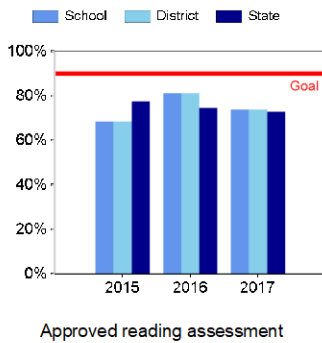

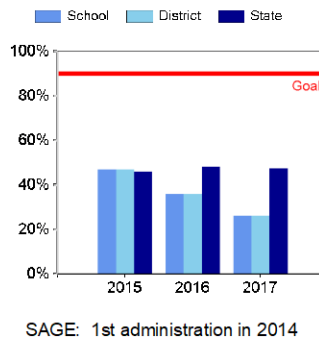
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 Grades K-6 School Year 2016-2017

3rd Grade Reading Proficiency



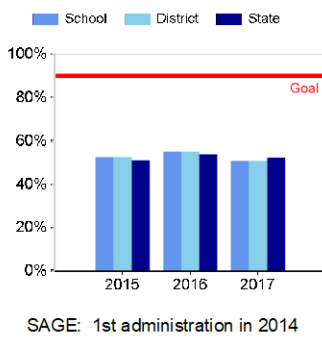
6th Grade ELA Proficiency



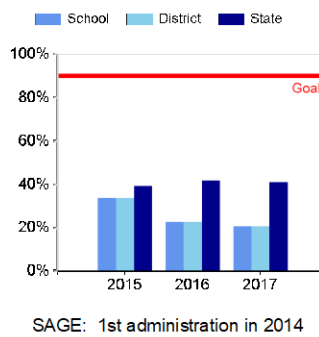
